Registration

- When registering, you are required to provide a sketch of your design/s with description of your design and material/s used. This must be submitted with entry by 1/6/2009.
- Contestants are encouraged to include notes on the inspiration for the design/s and a brief biography.
- No responsibility can be accepted for lost entries.
- Please note one entry only. Contestants can design up to a maximum of 3 outfits or 1 in each category.
- Entries will not be accepted from already 'established' designers.
- Contestants will need to have their own models to showcase their designs and ensure make up provision for their model/s.
- Entries will be shortlisted and contestants advised within 2 days if they are eligible to enter the contest. The official contest will be held on:

Date: Saturday, 4th July 2009, 6pm-9pm
Venue: Honor Oak Community Centre, 50 Turnham Road, SE4.
Time: 6pm-9pm

- No submissions will be accepted after the deadline for any reason. Contestants entering close to the posted deadline do so with this information in mind.
- If there are no eligible entries by the entry deadline (1/6/09) this contest will be cancelled or rescheduled.
- By entering, the winner agrees to authorize Lewisham Homes and the council to announce and publish their name in any forthcoming publicity, without remuneration should they decide to do.
- Prizes must be accepted as awarded and is not transferable or convertible to cash.

Acceptance of terms and conditions

- By entering, entrants agree to abide by the competition's rules and the decisions of the judges and Honor Oak Tenants and Residents Association (HOTRA), which are final.
- The contestant agrees to be fully responsible for any claim, expense, liability, losses, costs including legal fees incurred by us arising from any infringement of the terms and conditions set out in the terms and conditions.
- There will be no financial support provided by HOTRA or Lewisham Homes to help a contestant with their entry/ies.

Limitations of liability

Contestants assume liability for losses or injuries caused or claimed to be caused by participating in the Contest. HOTRA and Lewisham Homes are not responsible:

- (i) for any lost,
- (ii) late, illegible,

- (iv) postage-due,
- (v) misdirected or mutilated mail; or
- (vi) for any incorrect or inaccurate information, in the Contest or by any technical or human error that may occur in the processing of submissions in the Contest.

Modification

HOTRA and Lewisham Homes reserves the right to change any part of the terms and conditions without notice.

Judging and Notification

All entry designs that comply with the rules of the competition will be judged by a pre-selected panel of Judges. Lewisham Homes will advise successful contestants within 5 working days after 1/6/09. Shortlisting will be completed on 3/6/09.

If a potential contestant cannot be reached at the contact details provided on the entry form or does not reasonably respond by the 5/6/09, Judges have the right to refuse the contestant's entry to the competition.

Fashion Flair 2009 Categories

There are three categories for contestants to enter the competition and these are as follows;

1. **Design an outfit that is made of recycled materials or made from items seen at a convenience or hardware store.** Remember that for this category it is all about reducing, reusing and recycling resources. Garments should be made with these principles in mind

- so as much as possible use natural resources rather than toxic ones, and use recycled and reused products in your entries.

Your garment must be made from either;

- Household, Industrial, Manufactured or Man-Made Waste
- Re-used, Recycled Clothing, Objects and Fabric Off-Cuts
- Organic Waste

You should avoid using Staples & Sellotape, AND there must be NO sharp edges (mirrors, glass, or chicken-wire etc) anywhere on the garment. You are encouraged to use environmentally friendly glues, dyes, paints, resins etc in the construction of your garment.

2. Design an outfit for the Great Britain men/women athletics team for the opening ceremony of the 2012 London Olympics.

3. Design an outfit for a woman of any age that is suitable for a red carpet event

All garments must be well made, safe and durable, and able to be worn for rehearsal which will be held on Friday, 3rd July 2009, judging and performances. Please consider the weight and comfort of the garment, as your model will need to move freely on the stage.

Judging Criteria

Entries will be judged by an impartial panel of judges based on the following criteria:

- stylishness,
- imagination,
- fit/color/overall appearance,
- cost savings, and
- audience approval.

Prizes will be awarded to the top point-getter in each category.
